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#### **IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

#### Lodging/Boarding:

Each participant/school must remit **Rs. 500 (Rupees Five hundred) per head per day** against lodging and boarding. Money will be collected/deposited against boarding and lodging on full day basis and no part payment will be collected or deposited and the participating schools will not insist to refund of part payment. Dinning in the mess arranged by the host school is mandatory for the teams that opt to stay in the school provided accommodation. Team in need of stay facility must inform on **15<sup>th</sup>September 2024, by 4 pm.** 

Note: 1. If any team comes on 23<sup>rd</sup> and takes lunch then they will have to pay full day charge 2. If the team take dinner only on 23<sup>rd</sup> then they will have to pay half day charge Points 1 & 2 consider only 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024.

(Proforma Enclosed) – Minimum THREE DAYS boarding and lodging charges will have to be paid in Advance.

**Security Fee: -** An amount of **Rs.3000/-** will be charged per school as Security which is Refundable.

#### School Flag and ID card:

The Tournament will begin on 24<sup>th</sup> September, 2024 at 8:00 A.M with the Opening ceremony. It is mandatory for schools participating in the Tournament to attend the Inaugural Ceremony in proper suit or school uniform along with the school flag. The participants must carry their I Cards duly signed by the Principal and group photograph of the team along with the Principal, Team Manager and Coach. Team Coach/Manager also must carry their School I-Card. The participating teams are requested to bring one school flag and banner bearing the name of their school for ceremonies.

**Note:** Basketball Tournament will be conducted as per the rules and guidelines given in the CBSE Inter School Sports and Games Competition Calendar - 2024-25.

- 1. All the teams shall mandatorily be accompanied by a Teacher / Coach / Manager as designated by Principal of participating school.
- 2. Team(s) not accompanied by Team Manager / Coach will not be permitted to participate.
- 3. No team will be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team in lieu of a Coach / Manager, such information must be provided by the school on its official letter head.
- 4. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the team.
- 5. Participation in March Past is compulsory.
- 6. Documents for verification, in original, if asked for.
- 7. Medical check-up may also be advised by the Jury of Appeal or it may be appointed in case of overage suspicion.
- 8. List of online registration of all participants with their UID No. attested by the Principal is mandatory.

#### 9. Age-Criteria: A player shall be under 14, 17, & 19 years of age as of

31.12.2024. Accordingly, for session 2024-25, the age criteria will be as follows:

o Under 14 years: Born on or after 01.01.2011 o Under 17 years: Born on or after 01.01.2008 o Under 19 years: Born on or after 01.01.2006

Similarly, age may be calculated for other age-groups.

- 10. Players must carry their valid age proof certificates and School/CBSE Board Identity Card.
- 11. Players studying in class IX and above should provide CBSE registration number (If available).
- 12. Each school must issue an Identity Card to every participant of the school separately.
- 13. The hard copy of the CBSE Identity Card must be surrendered with the School Organizing Committee at the time of registration/reporting.
- 14. Entry of any person in the school without I-Card will be strictly prohibited.
- 15. Only one Coach and Manager will be accommodated with the team. Any other designated person accompanying the team will not be entertained for any matter at the venue and will not be permitted to stay in the campus.
- 16. The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the dues and receive the relevant certificates from school reception before leaving the school.
- 17. The school will not be responsible for any loss, illness or accident that occurs during the Basketball Tournament. The team coaches are responsible for their team's safety.
- 18. Team Manager/Coaches will be fully responsible for the discipline of their students in the field and also at the lodging place. In case of any damage is done to the school property during the stay by any participant or the team, it will have to be compensated from the respective Team Manager /Coach.
- 19. The teams are advised to report on time and exhibit a sense of responsibility and discipline.

#### 20. No offline Entry will be accepted.

- 21. Consumption of liquor, drugs, tobacco and smoking is strictly prohibited during the tournament and stay in the school. Anyone who violates this rule shall be asked to leave the school campus.
- 22. Players are not allowed to bring any costly ornament and valuable article. The school will not be responsible for the loss of any article during their stay. Locks should be brought by the teams.
- 23. Team Manager will be responsible for the conduct of the team in the field and in the school premises.

#### WITHDRAWING FROM TOURAMENT:

- 24. If a school, after filling in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament, it shall give a written request of its intention to the organizing school.
- 25. School withdrawing without information / requesting in writing to the organizing committee shall be penalized with a fine of Rs. 2,000/- (Rs. Two Thousand only).

#### PROTEST:

Protest of any nature in connection with tournament shall be in writing form and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within half an hour of declaration of the result ,duly accompanied by a fee of Rs. 2000/-

Such a protest will be considered by jury of appeal, consisting of the following:-

- 1. Principal of Organizing School.
- 2. Organizing Secretary.
- 3. CBSE Observer.
- 4. One or two technically qualified people present at the venue.

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# CENTRAL BOARD OF SECONDARY EDUCATION RULES OF SPORTS & GAMES BASKETBALL

- 1. The tournament will be conducted according to the latest and revised rules of Basketball Federation of India with modifications wherever applicable.
- 2. The number of players representing a school shall not more than twelve.
- 3. All the matches at Cluster level shall be conducted on knock out basis. In case the number of teams is less, the Cluster level tournament too may be organized on league basis.
- 4. At National level, the matches shall be conducted on league cum knock out basis.
- 5. At National level: All the teams reporting may be divided into different pools in such a way that by and large no pool is of less than four teams. From each pool, the two teams emerging on top will qualify to play the knock-out stage matches.
- 6. In any match, played on knock out basis including the final, if there is a tie, extension of five minutes shall continue to be given till the game is decided.
- 7. In case of a tie in matches played on league basis, the following procedure shall decide the winner, runner-up etc. i) The team which has beaten the other team in the league matches shall be the winner. ii) The tie between more than two teams will be decided on the basis of points scored and points against. The team securing the greatest quotient will be the winner. The points scored for and against shall be counted only in the matches played between the teams in tie. iii) If the tie still persists, the formula will be points scored points against. The team with highest difference is declared the winner. Again the scoring will be counted in the matches played between the teams in tie.
- 8. The number "6" size Ball will be used for under 14 Girls & Boys, under 17 & Under 19 Girls matches. The number "7" size Ball will be used for under 19 Boys.
- 9. A team shall be prepared to play more than two matches in a day.
- 10. All participating teams shall carry with them two sets of playing kit (uniform), one set of light colour and the other set of dark colour.
- 11. The team that has been named first in the fixture, will sit on the left side of the Official's Table, and shall score towards the right side of the court.
- 12. The school Organizing Cluster level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host school Principal and forwarded to the school organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Proforma.
- 13. Protest if any, must be submitted in writing along with the fee within 20 min after the declaration of the result.
- 14. In case a team intends to protest against the opposite team; the Captain of team that intends to protest, must sign the score sheet.
- 15. In case a team forfeits & walks out of the court without completing the match, it shall lose the right to submit any protest and shall be debarred from rest of the tournament.
